It offers a comprehensive introduction to the Six Sigma methodology, emphasizing its core principles and practical applications. The course equips participants with essential skills, including understanding the DMAIC process (Define, Measure, Analyze, Improve, Control), using basic statistical tools, and mapping processes. Yellow Belt participants learn how to effectively contribute to and support Six Sigma projects a/longside Green and Black Belts. A batch of 15 participants from WNS, Bollineni Medskills, HPCL etc. have attended the program. The program features assessments through quizzes and practical exercises, leading to certification upon successful completion.




















SEMINARS & MEETS
